

## Proposal for Unified Curriculum Summary

On February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011 in Los Angeles a combined meeting with the Elders, Teachers, and Evangelists Service Teams recognized that, historically, we have had a wide range of training programs around the world and we unanimously agreed to begin the development of a unified curriculum for the training of our full-time staff throughout our global fellowship of churches.

We recognize that this training should include at least three components:

1. Biblical Studies
2. Character and Relationship Development
3. Practical Ministry

We agreed, in principle, to adopt a unified curriculum, once the elements of the curriculum have been thoroughly established. In order to provide a broad spectrum of perspectives, we are recommending an establishment of a *Curriculum Development Board*, consisting of three elders, three teachers, and three evangelists. Each of these service teams would select representatives to serve in this capacity for a three-year term. In developing the curriculum, the Curriculum Development Board would solicit the input of various service teams and individuals in their area of expertise. This board would update the Delegates annually on the progress of curriculum development.

Delegates Decision: A “Yes” vote on this proposal means that we agree to a **Unified Curriculum** and the establishment of a **Curriculum Development Board**.
